Godlessness in the Last Days

But understand this, that in the last days there will come times of difficulty. ² For people will be lovers of self, lovers of money, proud, arrogant, abusive, disobedient to their parents, ungrateful, unholy, ³ heartless, unappeasable, slanderous, without self-control, brutal, not loving good, ⁴ treacherous, reckless, swollen with conceit, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, ⁵ having the appearance of godliness, but denying its power. Avoid such people. ⁶ For among them are those who creep into households and capture weak women, burdened with sins and led astray by various passions, ⁷ always learning and never able to arrive at a knowledge of the truth. ⁸ Just as Jannes and Jambres opposed Moses, so these men also oppose the truth, men corrupted in mind and disqualified regarding the faith. ⁹ But they will not get very far, for their folly will be plain to all, as was that of those two men.

¹⁰ You, however, have followed my teaching, my conduct, my aim in life, my faith, my patience, my love, my steadfastness, ¹¹ my persecutions and sufferings that happened to me at Antioch, at Iconium, and at Lystra—which persecutions I endured; yet from them all the Lord rescued me. ¹² Indeed, all who desire to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted, ¹³ while evil people and impostors will go on from bad to worse, deceiving and being deceived. ¹⁴ But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have firmly believed, knowing from whom you learned it ¹⁵ and how from childhood you have been acquainted with the sacred writings, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. ¹⁶ All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, ¹⁷ that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.

Natalie, missionary to Bulgaria, has had COVID 19 and found out that the virus and her other disease has affected her heart. She's going through major depression and having difficulty getting treatment there because of COVID. She now has hydrocephalus, had a stroke and has a benign tumor on her brain. Frank and Gensy's granddaughter, Hailey, had liver cancer which was diagnosed as cured. It is now back and is "really bad". See praises. Frank and Gensy are having a hard time finding out information about her as they're in Florida. Latest update is that she has had some really good days with an increase in appetite. Now having severe constipation and may go off hospice to see if it can be treated. An Indian Christian Brother, Crimson, who is a missionary in Libya is in danger there. Pray for God's protection for him and all Christians there as they are under heavy persecution.

Pam's friend, Sandy, was diagnosed with pancreatic cancer that is attached to her liver and is also in her lungs. Her radiation is finished and her doctor gives her nine months to a year to live. She started lower-dose chemo 3/29/22.

Sandy, in Santa Claus, IN, who is in Pam and Sue's bible study, was just diagnosed with possible pancreatic cancer. She survived breast cancer a few years ago. Had a biopsy 1/25 see Praise report now her oncologist doesn't believe that diagnosis from the doc who did her biopsy.

Pam's friend and colleague Vicki, a missionary to Mexico, has cancer of the femur and is receiving radiation treatments. She asks that we pray that God would heal her as a witness to God's mercy when doctors see the cancer is gone in the scan done before each treatment. She just had major surgery on her leg and is dealing with a great deal of pain. Vicki is now back in Mexico, but still not able to walk much and is getting Physical Therapy. They are starting a school in Pachuca, so pray for God's blessing on getting that started.
