Preach the Word

I charge you in the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who is to judge the living and the dead, and by his appearing and his kingdom: ² preach the word; be ready in season and out of season; reprove, rebuke, and exhort, with complete patience and teaching. ³ For the time is coming when people will not endure sound teaching, but having itching ears they will accumulate for themselves teachers to suit their own passions, ⁴ and will turn away from listening to the truth and wander off into myths. ⁵ As for you, always be sober-minded, endure suffering, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry.

⁶ For I am already being poured out as a drink offering, and the time of my departure has come. ⁷ I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. ⁸ Henceforth there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, will award to me on that day, and not only to me but also to all who have loved his appearing.

May it not be charged against them! ¹⁷ But the Lord stood by me and strengthened me, so that through me the message might be fully proclaimed and all the Gentiles might hear it. Paul's Final Words to Timothy

2 Timothy 4 / June 18, 2022

1. The Charge: Preach the Word (4:1-2)

- **Urgency**
I charge you
- **Source**
in the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who is to judge the living and the dead, and by his appearing and his kingdom:
- **Action**
preach the word;
- **Characteristics**
be ready in season and out of season; reprove, rebuke, and exhort,
- **Method**
with complete patience and teaching.

2. The Explanation for the Charge (4:3-4)

- **Reject Biblical Truth**
For the time is coming when people will not endure sound teaching,
- **Search for Subjective Truth**
but having itching ears they will accumulate for themselves teachers to suit their own passions, and
- **Suffer the Consequences**
will turn away from listening to the truth and wander off into myths.

3. The Preparation for the Charge (4:5)

- **Be free from mental and spiritual "drunkenness"**
As for you, always be sober-minded,
- **Embrace opposition patiently**
endure suffering,
- **Engage in the hard work of sharing the "good news" of the gospel**
do the work of an evangelist,
- **Complete God's call of service**
fulfill your ministry.

4. The Outcome of the Charge (4:6-8)

- **Priest: Pouring out of a drink offering**
For I am already being poured out as a drink offering, and

- **Sailor: Putting out to sea**
the time of my departure has come.
- **Soldier: Ending the war**
I have fought the good fight,
- **Runner: Completing the race**
I have finished the race,
- **Farmer: Protecting the harvest**
I have kept the faith.
- **Athlete: Receiving the Prize**
Henceforth there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, will award to me on that day, and not only to me but also to all who have loved his appearing.

5. The Isolation of the Charge (4:9-22)

- **Deserted by his friends (4:9-13)**
Do your best to come to me soon.
For Demas, in love with this present world, has deserted me and gone to Thessalonica.
Crescens has gone to Galatia,
Titus to Dalmatia.
Luke alone is with me.
Get Mark and bring him with you, for he is very useful to me for ministry.
Tychicus I have sent to Ephesus.
When you come, bring the cloak that I left with Carpus at Troas, also the books, and above all the parchments.
- **Opposed by Critics (4:14-15)**
Alexander the coppersmith did me great harm; the Lord will repay him according to his deeds.
Beware of him yourself, for he strongly opposed our message.
- **Unsupported at his defense (4:16-18)**
At my first defense no one came to stand by me, but all deserted me. May it not be charged against them! But the Lord stood by me and strengthened me, so that through me the message might be fully proclaimed and all the Gentiles might hear it. So I was rescued from the lion's mouth.
The Lord will rescue me from every evil deed and bring me safely into his heavenly kingdom.
To him be the glory forever and ever. Amen.
