DECLARE THE SECOND COMING 4:14-15

1. Jesus' Death and Resurrection

For since we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so,

2. Jesus' Return

through Jesus, God will bring with him those who have fallen asleep.

Lazarus

After saying these things, he said to them, "Our friend Lazarus has fallen asleep, but I go to awaken him." The disciples said to him, "Lord, if he has fallen asleep, he will recover." Now Jesus had spoken of his death, but they thought that he meant taking rest in sleep. Then Jesus told them plainly, "Lazarus has died, and for your sake I am glad that I was not there, so that you may believe. But let us go to him." So Thomas, called the Twin, said to his fellow disciples, "Let us also go, that we may die with him." (John 11:11-16, ESV)

Resurrection of Jesus

And Jesus cried out again with a loud voice and yielded up his spirit. And behold, the curtain of the temple was torn in two, from top to bottom. And the earth shook, and the rocks were split. The tombs also were opened. And **many bodies of the saints who had fallen asleep were raised,** and coming out of the tombs after his resurrection they went into the holy city and appeared to many. (Matthew 27:50-53, ESV)

3. Jesus' Reunion with Christians

For this we <u>declare</u> to you by a word from the Lord, that we who are alive, who are left until the coming (*Parousia*) of the Lord, will not precede those who have fallen asleep.
